Don't say: My salary is cheap.

Say: My salary is low.

Don't say: I wish I can speak German.

Say: I wish I could speak German.

Don't say: I wish I have a lot of money.

Say: I wish I had a lot of money.

Don't say: I look forward to meet you.

Say: I look forward to meeting you.

Don't say: My office is in the 3rd floor.

Say: My office is on the 3rd floor.

Don't say: I came from Japan.

Say: I come from Japan.

Don't say: I cut my hair. (You cut your own hair.)

Say: I had a haircut. (A hairstylist/barber cut your hair.)

Don't say: I left home at 7:30 o'clock.

Say: I left home at 7:30.

Don't say: I cooked salad for dinner.

Say: I made salad for dinner.

Don't say: Does he has a car?

Say: Does he have a car?

Don't say: He didn't came to the party last night.

Say: He didn't come to the party last night.

Don't say: Is your job busy?

Say: Are you busy at work?

Don't say: I play Judo.

Say: I do Judo.

Don't say: We met him two days before.

Say: We met him two days ago.

Don't say: I went to a business trip last month.

Say: I went on a business trip last month.
